Kirk Kindsfater C/3B #4	1979	4-year starter, All-State, 1 st Team All-Conference, hit over .370 in each of final 3 seasons, threw out 2 runners to allow comeback in Districts to advance to State
Larry Lawhead P/3B #4	1978	All-Northern Division, hit .333 as jr., scored tying run in win over University to send Reds to league title playoff, knocked in 1 st run in 2-1 win over Roosevelt
Brett Weber P/SS #1	1978	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-Conference, hit .400 as sr., 151 career innings with 160 K's, clinched Reds' 1 st postseason win of the decade with CG, 1 ER, 4-hitter
Brett Holcomb CF #6	1977	1 st Team All-Northern Division, scored game-winning run over University to send Reds to '76 league title playoff, scored 8 th inning GW run to beat Berthoud in '77
Randy Kurtz P/2B #2	1977	All-Northern Division, 3 runs in '76 Regionals defeated Denver Lutheran, scored 7 th inning tying run in win over Windsor, scored 3 runs in win over University
Craig Collins P/C/CF #4	1976	KFKA WELCO Player of the Year, All-State, 2.11 ERA, 80 K's, slugged .683 w/ 6 HR, won league title playoff with 1-hitter, won district semifinals, won Regional Title
Dan Knight P/CF #3	1976	1 st Team All-Northern Division, 3.67 ERA as senior, took HBP and scored GW run in Regional Championship, scored GW run in Districts to send Reds to State
Bob Beets P/3B #3	1975	All-Northern Division, hit .366 and slugged .707 as sr., hit game-winning home run over Platte Valley, threw complete-game 4-hitter to beat Roosevelt in league
Jack Cazer P/CF #5	1974	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-Northern Division, KFKA All-Star Team, threw one-hitter with 9 K's to beat Denver Christian, singled in GW run over Roosevelt
Marty Damrell C/#3	1974	1 st Team All-Northern Division, hit over .300 and slugged .509, singled home game-winning run over Windsor, 6 th inning home run defeated Highland in league
Rick Goering 1B #4	1974	All-Northern Division, hit .349 and slugged .558 as sr., singled and scored GW run in 11 th inning win over Weld Central, led Reds in 7 th inning rally over Windsor
Rick McClure 3B #2	1974	4-year starter, 1 st Team All-Northern Division, hit over .320 in each of 3 seasons with 7 2Bs as jr., bases-loaded 3B beat Fort Lupton, scored GW run vs. Roosevelt
Mike Eldridge P/C #3	1973	1 st Team All-Conference, KFKA All-Star Team, hit .468 as jr., slugged .725 as sr., posted 1.75 ERA, hit 2 HR and triple and threw 3-hitter to beat Highland in league
Don Donahoo P/CF #4	1972	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .375, 67 K's, 6-1 record as sr., threw CG 2-hit shutout to defeat University and threw CG 3-hitter to defeat Highland in key league games
Tim Kawakami 2B #2	1972	All-Northern Division, hit .375, scored 24 runs, 18 stolen bases, led Reds with 3 runs to beat University, then scored GW run in 7 th inning to sweep University
Steve Strong P/CF #3	1972	1 st Team All-Conference, hit .508, 4 home runs, 28 RBI, 23 stolen bases, 33 runs, 58 K's as a pitcher, 3 HR, 4 runs, and 6 RBI to beat Highland in key league game

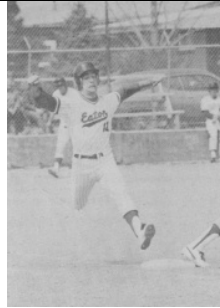

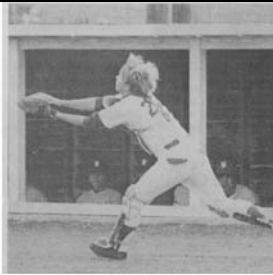

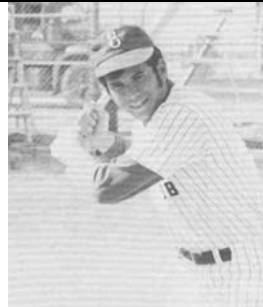

Gary Hoffner 2B	1975	2-year starter, led rally and scored in 7 th inning comeback win over Highland
Gregg Schneider P	1975	2-year starter, 0.92 ERA as a junior, 11 K's and 0 ER in CG win over Platte Valley
Doug Stroberg RF	1974	2-year starter, hit .429 as sr., slugged .673, 2 hits, 3 RBI led to big comeback win
Pat Wright LF	1974	2-year starter, hit .373 as sr., 9 SB, 4 hits, 4 runs led to big win over Platte Valley
Mark Nelson 2B/SS	1973	2-year starter, scored 4 runs to lead Reds in big non-league win over Holy Family
Randy Vogel RF	1973	2-year starter, scored 2 runs including game-winner to beat Platte Valley
Doug Schnorr LF	1972	2-year starter, led Reds to big win to end '72 season with single, double, 4 RBI
